COVID-19 TIPS FOR DRIVING & TRAVELING SAFE

In 2020, safe driving includes being mindful of new health threats like the Pandemic Coronavirus (Covid-19). Working with the expertise of medical experts, we've developed a basic list of tips to help keep you safe on the road during quarantine and beyond.

Tip #1: Stock up

Fill your car with cleaning essentials like tissues, disinfectant wipes and hand sanitizer (make sure it's at least 70% alcohol!)



Tip #2: Disinfect Daily

Wipe hot spots like your center console, steering wheel & dashboard. Be careful not to use damaging bleach or ammonia-based cleaners



Tip #3: Face Covering

Per CDC guidelines, wear face masks and try to limit your travel and if possible, only travel with members of your own household



Tip #4: Crack Windows

Open your car's windows to keep air flowing, especially before and after driving, since Coronavirus can live in the air for up to 3 hours



Tip #5: Social Distancing

You can help reduce the spread of coronavirus by limiting the amount of passengers in your car: 1 in the front, 1 in the back
